1. Welcome and Introductions
2. Reports

**Students:** Student government students had their first meeting last Sunday. They voted on whether to have a dance, or the Art Gala and decided to hold the Art Gala again. Their theme this year is to promote unity and collaboration across campuses. During the next few weeks they will work to get more students involved in activities and they will have a new website for IHS student government. There are positions open on student government. Applications are available in the IHS offices and are due September 23.

**Parents:** Parents did not have a report for this meeting.

**Staff:** The IHS staff met at the coast on Monday and Tuesday, August 29 and 30. Monday was on teachers' own time and the staff paid their for their own lodging.

We are excited to have new and wonderful staff. New staff members are Devan Fahsholz, Gus Alchondo, Alicia Sterling and Jenny Hehnke. Steve Smith is returning to IHS after two years teaching in South Korea.

The opening assembly will be held the last week of September. All students from all three campuses will meet in the South Eugene Auditorium.

3. Governance

Site council members went over some items in the governance document including the following:

Big-picture budget decisions and staffing decisions are brought to the site council

Membership usually includes nine Eugene IHS teachers. This year only seven teachers are available to serve so we will only have seven IHS teachers. We like to have one parent and one alternate parent from each campus. We will try to get more parents who are interested to serve.

Meetings are held on the second Tuesday of the month and we try to keep the fourth Tuesday of the month available in case we need an emergency meeting.

Convening and recording rotates among the members of the site council. Recorders will get the minutes to the head teacher and she will get them out to members.

Decision making on the site council is by consensus and a quorum needs to be present.

The Governance document was approved with full consensus with added clause that only seven Eugene IHS teachers will serve during the 2016/17 school year.

#### 4. IB Report

Jocelyn Harley went over the IB results for 2016. Seventy-two students (40% of the senior class) were diploma candidates in May 2016 and 85% passed.

IB does not break down scores by campus, but at the IB summit, teachers do see their own students' scores.

IB registration and fees are due October 17, 2016.

#### 5. EEF Grant Report

The timing of the EEF grant applications has changed to the spring & are awarded the next school year in the fall. EEF likes the grants to be for things that would not otherwise happen without the grants.

Eugene IHS applied for grants to purchase laptops for the learning support specialist. We were granted \$3,000 and will purchase eight computers.
