What are your plans to continue work with this person? • Update your research question on your Extended Essay page on ManageBac. • Review and Update your Works Cited list in Managebac. • Please come to class knowing your Managebac password.
Wednesday, September 20th Mandatory Meeting	Attend Seminar. Submit completed/signed Parent Signature Form to your seminar teacher. We will be meeting with the Juniors to reflect on the seminar and extended essay processes.

Friday, Oct 6th	Deadline for students to log 15 hours of CAS that teacher approves, in order to achieve passing grades at midterm.

Please inquire if and where you will need to turn in a copy your paper. • Draft must be at least 3,000 words (where the final draft will be 3500-4000 words) and must include a Works Cited Page. It should also include <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Title page ○ Table of contents ○ Effective introduction ○ Organized sections, with all research included, as well as any charts and graphs, parenthetical references ○ Effective conclusion ○ Works Cited pages, appendices • IB Candidates will log a reflection in the “Planning and Progress” section of their EE page in Managebac. Seminar teachers will provide guidance as to what is expected.
<p>Wednesday, Nov 1st Mandatory Meeting</p>	<p>Seminar meeting, in which seminar teachers will return your working final draft of your Extended Essay to you.</p>
<p>Monday, November 20th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • By noon today, submit one (1) copy of your final paper to the box that your seminar teacher will leave in the IHS office at your campus. Also, submit a revised copy of your essay to turnitin.com. Remember to keep an extra hard copy for yourself, and also back up your essay in multiple places. IB Diploma candidates will upload a copy to Managebac for verification. Copies of a submitted paper will be uploaded to IB for diploma consideration. • Submit copy of final paper to your T.A.; remind him or her of deadline for review and response. • Complete self-evaluation in class. • IB candidates will log their final reflection in the “Planning and Progress” section of their EE page in Managebac. Seminar teachers will provide guidance as to what is expected.
