OREGON STATE UNIVERSITY

Oregon State recognizes IB achievement by awarding credit to students who score 4 or above on standard and higher level IB exams. OSU also grants additional benefits for students who complete the full IB diploma with a score of 30 or higher including Sophomore standing and a renewable annual scholarship of \$3000. The IB Organization has indicated that they will offer a dual route for the May 2021 Diploma Programme examination session. Oregon State University will continue to award credit for both exam options according to our published exam credit policy based on scores provided by IB. Students must indicate that they would like official test scores sent to OSU. The official International Baccalaureate Certificate is required in order to award credit. Contact your IB Coordinator or IB North America to request score reports.

UNIVERSITY OF OREGON

The University of Oregon evaluates International Baccalaureate scores in much the same way it evaluates AP scores. Students must indicate that they want their official IB scores sent to the UO. The University of Oregon values IB curriculum and gives certain special privileges for completers of the IB Diploma, as well as having generous credit policies for both HL and SL exams. Applicants should be averaging at least 4's and 5's to be competitive for admission. Applicants who are pursuing or have completed the full IB Diploma should indicate in the Special Circumstances section of the application if you are pursuing or have completed the full IB Diploma. New freshman applicants starting in the fall term who complete the full IB Diploma will have the GPA requirement of the Summit or the Apex scholarship waived. Starting with Fall 2021, in recognition of students' successful completion of the rigorous International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, the University of Oregon offers the IB Diploma Scholarship Program. Scholarship dollar amounts are based on the total score received on IB exams and residency. IB Exemplar Scholarship: IB score range 33+, \$3000/year for residents, \$6000/year for non-residents; IB Scholar Scholarship: IB score range 28-32, \$2000/year for residents, \$4000/year for non-residents; IB Milestone Scholarship: IB score range 24-27, \$1000/year for residents, \$2000/year for non-residents. IB Diploma Scholarships may be combined with other UO scholarships, with the exception of the Stamps Scholarship. IB Diploma Scholarships help the UO to meet the PathwayOregon commitment. You must enroll at the UO in the fall term of your freshman year and you must enroll in 12 University of Oregon credits each term to receive this award. PORTLAND STATE UNIVERSITY

Students who complete IB exams and receive creditable scores may, upon admission to Portland State, be granted credit toward a bachelor's degree. Students enrolling at Portland State who earn their IB diploma with a score of 30 or above will receive a total of 45 college credits and sophomore class standing. To be awarded college credit, a minimum score is required for both Standard Level (SL) and Higher Level (HL) exams. Specific credit will be awarded based on individual exam scores and the session when the exam was taken. Where no specific numeric PSU course is awarded, LD indicates lower division elective credit and UD indicates upper division elective credit awarded in the department specified.
