The Program

Spanish Immersion is a rigorous program in which students complete as much as 50% of the coursework over twelve years in Spanish. In June of 1994, the first students completing twelve years of a Spanish Immersion Program graduated from Eugene International High School on the Sheldon High School campus.

The Spanish Immersion Program is a unique magnet program, focusing on students developing fluency and using Spanish in interdisciplinary studies which culminate with the International Baccalaureate and Advanced Placement curriculum. Many Spanish Immersion students sit for the International Baccalaureate Higher Level Spanish examination as seniors and score above the international mean.
